


Dr. Gilman is based at the University of Florida. He conducts extensive research on important tree care practices such as pruning, irrigation, fertilizer, root pruning to improve root systems and non-traditional containers for nursery production.

He has assembled a unique urban tree teaching program for helping municipalities, arborists, educators, growers and landscapers that implement programs promoting better tree health in cities.

Dr. Gilman is a regular contributor to the ISA (International Society of Arboriculture). He was awarded the Research Award in 2007, the Educators Award in 2003 and the Authors Citation Award in 1999.

He has published more than 96 scientific articles in 30 years in academia and industry.
